The cost of both of them together is in one of the boxes bellow.

£1.85	75p	£1.74	£2.25	£1	£1.56
£2.10	80p	£1.80	£3.06	£1.44	£1.50
£1.60	£1.25	£1.20	90p	£1.45	£1.27

Use these clues to find out how much he paid:

- You need more than 3 coins to make this amount.
- There would be change from the most valuable coin.
- The crisps cost more than 50p.
- You could pay without using any copper coins.
- The ice-cream cost exactly twice as much as the crisps.
